It's not too late to register for the Philadelphia Chapter's annual Jumpstart event! Travel with your LVAGO friends to enjoy a full-day organ music festival held at Bryn Mawr Presbyterian Church. The theme this year is From the Old World to the New: British and American Organs and Organ Music, featuring an array of concerts and workshops. Presenters are Jeffrey Gemmel on Moravian choral music, James Kealey on British organ music, and Douglas Reed on American organ music, with special premieres by Libby Larsen and Trevor Weston. This year, there will be a variety of Breakout Sessions that complement and contrast the day's opening worship service and its two organ recitals. Topics to be discussed in these sessions include Organ Preservation, The Composer's Process, British Organ Music for Manuals, Choir Tours, Tips and Tricks for the Substitute/Part-Time Organist, and a masterclass on American Repertoire. Coffee, tea, lunch and a free music exchange are included.
